- 1) The bridge has continued to function well with no problems. The December 3, 2007 high water event posed no problems to the bridge. The landowner, the Council and Paul Johnson continue to monitor the project. No maintenance has been required.
- 2) One challenge has been maintaining riparian vegetation, in particular, western red cedar. Approximately 10 western red cedars were planted, but only three are surviving – the hemlock planted appears to be doing well. The riparian area is fairly shaded which may account of these trees not growing.
- 3) The project was featured in the local Tualatin Valley chapter of the Association of NW Steelheaders, the statewide Association of NW Steelheaders quarterly publication, the Capitol Press, the OWEB Small Grant Biennial Report, 2005-07; the Tualatin River Watershed Council 2006-07 Annual Report and the Council website, http://www.trwc.org/basin_projects/bateman-bridges.html.

A tour of the project was included in a June 2007 Lower Willamette West Small Grant tour.
