Cathy Kellon, Executive Director**

Cathy has over 20 years of experience designing and applying strategic approaches to improve habitat for native fish and wildlife, build public awareness about the value of nature's services, and increase community access to clean water. Cathy became Executive Director of the Watershed Council in January of 2019. She was previously the Director of the Working Waters Program as the non-profit organization, the GEOS Institute and prior to that she was the Water and Watersheds Program Director at Ecotrust. She has worked with NOAA Fisheries and the Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board. Cathy earned her Master's degree in Geography, with a minor in Water Resources Studies, from Oregon State University.

Daniel Newberry has worked in watershed management since 1993, including serving as a hydrologist with both the Mt.
