The TRWC's IRS Form 990 is an informational tax form that most tax-exempt organizations must file annually. In a nutshell, the form gives the IRS an overview of the organization's activities, governance, and detailed financial information.

Scott will present a brief overview of considerations that TRWC may include when constructing a Land Acknowledgement statement. The presentation will also provide four examples of Land Acknowledgements from other organizations: Columbia Land Trust, Willamette University, McMenasins, and Tryon Creek Watershed Council.

A Land Acknowledgement is a respectful public recognition of the Indigenous history of the land. A Land Acknowledgement is given by the host or facilitator of an event or gathering unless a specific person has been requested to share the Acknowledgement. The Land Acknowledgement is given regardless of whether Indigenous individuals are present or not.
